Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver more than 200 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

We are planning the development of an education campus at the Murwillumbah High School site. The project will include a primary school, a high school, and school community health facilities co-located within an integrated, purpose designed and built education campus.

Design process continuing

The proposed master plan for the campus was presented to the community at an information hub in late March 2021, providing an opportunity for the community to view artist impressions, ask questions and provide feedback. The project is currently in the concept design phase. As part of this process principals and staff representatives from each school have been

participating in design consultation workshops to determine the final location of learning spaces and core facilities. Once the concept design is finalised it will be shared with the community for feedback.

VECI consultant appointed

A very early contractor involvement (VECI) contract has been awarded to Built Pty. Ltd. Under the agreement, Built is providing specialist advice on a range of design and construction matters.

Next steps

- Finalise concept design and share with the community for feedback.
- Develop the construction staging approach, including scope and timing of site preparation works.
- Prepare Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), schematic design, and other documentation required for the State Significant Development Application.
