Murwillumbah High School upgrade Project update | August 2024



Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Murwillumbah High School is being upgraded so students and staff can return to the school from the beginning of the 2025 school year.

The upgrade will provide significantly improved classrooms and specialist learning spaces with new paint, floor coverings, energy-efficient LED lighting, air conditioning, furniture, fittings, and equipment.

Progress update

The demolition phase of the project, including removal of surplus buildings and hazardous materials, has been completed ahead of schedule. The inside of the buildings to be refurbished are now all stripped, with spaces looking very tidy and ready for fit out.

Main works contract awarded

We are pleased to advise that Hutchison Builders has been awarded the contract for the next and most significant phase of work at Murwillumbah High School, which includes the majority of internal refurbishment as well as landscaping and exterior works.

Through the tender evaluation process, Hutchison demonstrated its commitment and ability to deliver the amount of work required at the school to a high standard and strict timeframe.

The work done as part of this contract will ensure Murwillumbah High School recommences operations on Day 1 Term 1 2025. Further works are set to be delivered in 2025, and we are working with the school leadership to ensure these works do not disrupt teaching and learning.


Notification of upcoming works

From Monday 19 August 2024, Hutchison Builders will start setting up their site compound at Murwillumbah High School. These site establishment works are expected to take approximately 4 weeks and will include:

- Preparing and fencing the compound area
- Creating a contractor parking area and vehicle entry points
- Mobilising machinery
- Delivering and setting up the site sheds.

Traffic management will be in place to make sure all vehicle movements are conducted safely. Work during the site establishment phase will be between 7 am and 5 pm, Monday to Fridays.

As shown in the site map below, the site compound will be located inside the school boundary near the corner of Nullum Street and High School Lane. Additional vehicle entry points will be created from Nullum Street and High School Lane to provide contractor and delivery access to the compound.
