# Project overview

A project is underway to upgrade Narrabeen North Public School and Narrabeen Sports High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

At Narrabeen North Public School, the project will provide:

- new flexible permanent learning spaces
- upgraded learning spaces
- new supported learning spaces
- upgrades to core facilities, including the library, administration and hall.

At Narrabeen Sports High School, the project will provide:

- new and upgraded learning spaces
- upgraded supported learning spaces
- new amenities and refurbished gym

#### **Progress Update**

A Development Application (DA) has been lodged with Northern Beaches Council to seek approval to remove trees located within the proposed construction footprint at both schools. The DA was submitted late July 2022 and will be made publicly available on the council's website. To offset the loss of canopy, a tree replacement programme will be implemented to increase tree coverage across the sites with local native trees.

#### **Next Steps**

Statutory planning approvals will progress with the lodgement of a second development application (DA) with the Northern Beaches Council for the upgrades to both schools.
