

Narrabeen North Public School upgrade

Works notification | 26 October 2023

We are upgrading Narrabeen North Public School with improved education facilities to support the student community.

Power and data supply works from Thursday 26 October

As advised in our September 2023 project update, 14 demountables were removed from the school to make space for the new school facilities. There are 4 remaining demountables at the school which require connection to permanent power and data sources.

From Thursday 26 October we will start excavation works to create a new underground cabling pathway to the demountables. This process is expected to take one week, weather and site conditions pending.

Underbore drilling to connect power and data sources to the demountables will occur on **Saturday 28 and Sunday 29 October**. This will involve large vehicle movements, including a truck and directional drilling machine. Traffic control will be in place for the safety of motorists and pedestrians. Access to residential properties will not be affected.

All works will be conducted within the school boundaries. Perimeter fencing will be installed around the work areas to prevent access and will remain in place until the works are complete. Please refer to the map overleaf for the location of works and vehicle movements.

The drilling works may cause some noise on-site on Saturday 28 October from 8:00 am and 5:00 pm and Sunday 29 October from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm. We apologise for any inconvenience.
