



Narrabeen North Public School upgrade

Project update | September 2023

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver new and upgraded facilities at Narrabeen North Public School.

This project will deliver 2 new buildings which feature:

- 15 permanent general classrooms, including 3 support classrooms and amenities (Block E)
- administration areas, staff offices, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), hall, amenities and storage spaces (Block D).

Progress summary

The following activities have been finished at the school since we received approval of the Development Application (DA) in June 2023:

- site establishment, which included installing temporary safety fencing and shade cloth, tree removal, and setting up site sheds and temporary amenities
- demolition of Blocks J and H and the removal of 14 demountables to make space for the new Blocks D and E
- demolition of the covered outdoor learning area (COLA), which will be replaced by a new COLA in Block D.

Early works to prepare the foundation for Blocks D and E have started and are expected to be finished in October 2023, after which construction can begin.

Construction work hours

Standard working hours will be 7 am to 6 pm Monday to Friday, and 8 am to 1 pm on Saturdays. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays unless otherwise advised.
