

Narrabeen North Public School upgrade

Works notification | 4 July 2024

We are upgrading Narrabeen North Public School with improved education facilities to support the student community.

Works during the July school holidays

We will be undertaking several construction activities over the upcoming school holidays from Saturday 6 July to Saturday 20 July, weather permitting. Works are planned during this time to minimise disruption to school operations.

Hoarding modification

The current hoarding that separates the construction site from the main school campus will be replaced with temporary fencing. This will allow progression of landscaping and associated works.

Landscaping works within the existing school grounds

These works include removing the garden shed in order to integrate the landscaping in the area and install new bike racks within the school grounds.

Temporary entry pathway on Namona Street

Removal of the existing entry pathway on Namona Street is required to carry out landscaping works.

A temporary entry pathway will be set up to provide newly constructed access to the school. This temporary entry pathway will be appropriately fenced off to allow safe access of students, staff and the public at all times.

Work hours

All work will be carried out during standard construction hours which are Monday to Friday 7 am to 5 pm, and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless notified.
