



Narrabeen North Public School upgrade

Project update | June 2024

Project overview

As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget has committed funding to progress the upgrade of Narrabeen North Public School. This project will deliver 2 new buildings which will feature:

- Administration areas, staff offices, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), hall, amenities and storage spaces (Block D)
- 15 permanent classrooms, including 3 support classrooms and amenities (Block E).

Progress summary

The following construction activities have been undertaken since March 2024:

- Fit-out of Block D ground floor and level 1 has continued, including;
 - installation of windows and doors
 - completion of hall ceiling framing and sheeting
 - painting, joinery installation and lighting works.
- Fit-out of Block E ground floor and level 1 has continued, including;
 - completion of internal wall linings
 - installation of ceilings, windows and doors
 - installation of joinery, lift, handrails and balustrades.
- The new fire hydrant booster and electrical kiosk substation have been installed with permanent power connected.



- External landscaping, including the new school entry pathway on Namona Street, has started.

Next steps

The following activities will be undertaken over the coming months:

- installation of furniture and equipment
- completion of Blocks D and E
- landscaping.

Construction work hours

Construction work hours are Monday to Friday 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays unless otherwise advised.
