



# Narrabeen North Public School upgrade

Project update | March 2024

## Project overview

As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget has committed funding to progress the upgrade of Narrabeen North Public School. This project will deliver 2 new buildings which feature:

- 15 permanent classrooms, including 3 support classrooms and amenities (Block E)
- administration areas, staff offices, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), hall, amenities and storage spaces (Block D).

## Progress summary

Construction at the school has been progressing steadily through 2024.

Since the summer school holidays the following works have been undertaken:

- the ground floor and level 1 concrete slabs were poured for Blocks D and E
- the structural steel works for Blocks D and E on the ground floor and level 1 were completed
- work on the façade for Block D has been progressing
- work on the interiors of Blocks D and E has been progressing
- structural steel for the COLA was installed
- the upgrade to the fire hydrant was finished.

## Next steps

The following activities will be undertaken in the next 2 months:

- façade works for Blocks D and E
- work on the interior of the ground floor and level 1 for Blocks D and E
- external works landscaping will start
- work on installing the new Namona Street kiosk electricity substation will start.

## Construction work hours

Construction work hours over the holidays are Monday to Friday 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays unless otherwise advised.
