



Narrabeen Sports High School upgrade

Project update | December 2023

Project overview

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget has committed funding to progress the upgrade of Narrabeen Sports High School. This project will deliver:

- renewal and repairs for the science labs, prep rooms, and chemical storerooms in Block B
- replacement of all roofs in Blocks B, D and E
- refurbishment of student and staff amenities (bathrooms and changerooms)
- upgraded technological and applied studies (TAS) classrooms in Block A
- refurbishment of existing classrooms within Block C
- refurbishment of Block K including data upgrades.

Discussions with the school about future upgrades to core facilities are continuing.

Progress summary

Refurbishment works started in mid-September. Since then the following progress has been made:

- The replacement of all roofing in Block E was finished in October and Block D in early December.
- Construction of the roofing in Block B and part of Block A started in late November and is expected to be finished by late December.
- Internal refurbishment of the classrooms and movement areas on the top 2 levels of Block E was finished in December.
- The refurbishment of the bathrooms in Block D was finished in December.
- The refurbishment of the bathrooms in Block E started and is expected to be finished by late January 2024, in time for the school to use from Day 1 Term 1.

- Designs for the new science, technology, engineering and mathematics room, and upgraded woodwork, textile and computer rooms are finished. We expect to procure a contractor for these works early in 2024, after which construction will start.
- Progress was made on the renewal of the science labs, prep rooms and chemical storerooms in Block B and is expected to be finished in time for the school to use from Day 1 Term 1 2024.
- A contractor was appointed in early December to undertake the data upgrades to Block K. These works are expected to be finished in time for Day 1 Term 1 2024.
- A construction contract was awarded to undertake the upgrades to the Block A gymnasium changeroom and toilet facilities. Work will start during the summer school holidays.
- Design of the internal refurbishment of Block C is expected to start in February 2024.

Construction work hours

Construction work hours over the holidays are Monday to Friday 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays unless otherwise advised.
