

Renewed and refurbished science lab at Narrabeen Sports High School

Narrabeen Sports High School upgrade

Project update | March 2024

Project overview

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

The 2023-24 Budget has committed funding to progress the upgrade of Narrabeen Sports High School. This project will deliver:

- renewal and repairs for the science labs, prep rooms, and chemical storerooms in Block B
- replacement of all roofs in Blocks B, D and E
- refurbishment of student and staff amenities (bathrooms and changerooms)
- upgraded technological and applied studies (TAS) classrooms in Block A
- refurbishment of existing classrooms within Block C
- refurbishment of Block K including data upgrades.

Progress summary

Since our last update in December 2023 the following progress has been made:

- Roof upgrades were made to Blocks B, D, E and part of Block A.
- Stage 1 of the bathroom refurbishment in Block E was finished in time for the school to use from Day 1 Term 1 2024. Stage 2 was finished and handed to the school in mid-March 2024.
- Renewal and refurbishment of the science labs, prep rooms and chemical storerooms in Block B were finished and handed to the school in mid-February 2024.
- The upgrade to Block K, which included 6 classrooms with a seminar room, staff room, storage room, new communication room and data upgrades were also finished in February 2024.
- Work on the upgrades to the Block A gymnasium changeroom and toilet facilities started during the summer school holidays and was finished and handed to the school in mid-March 2024.

Next steps

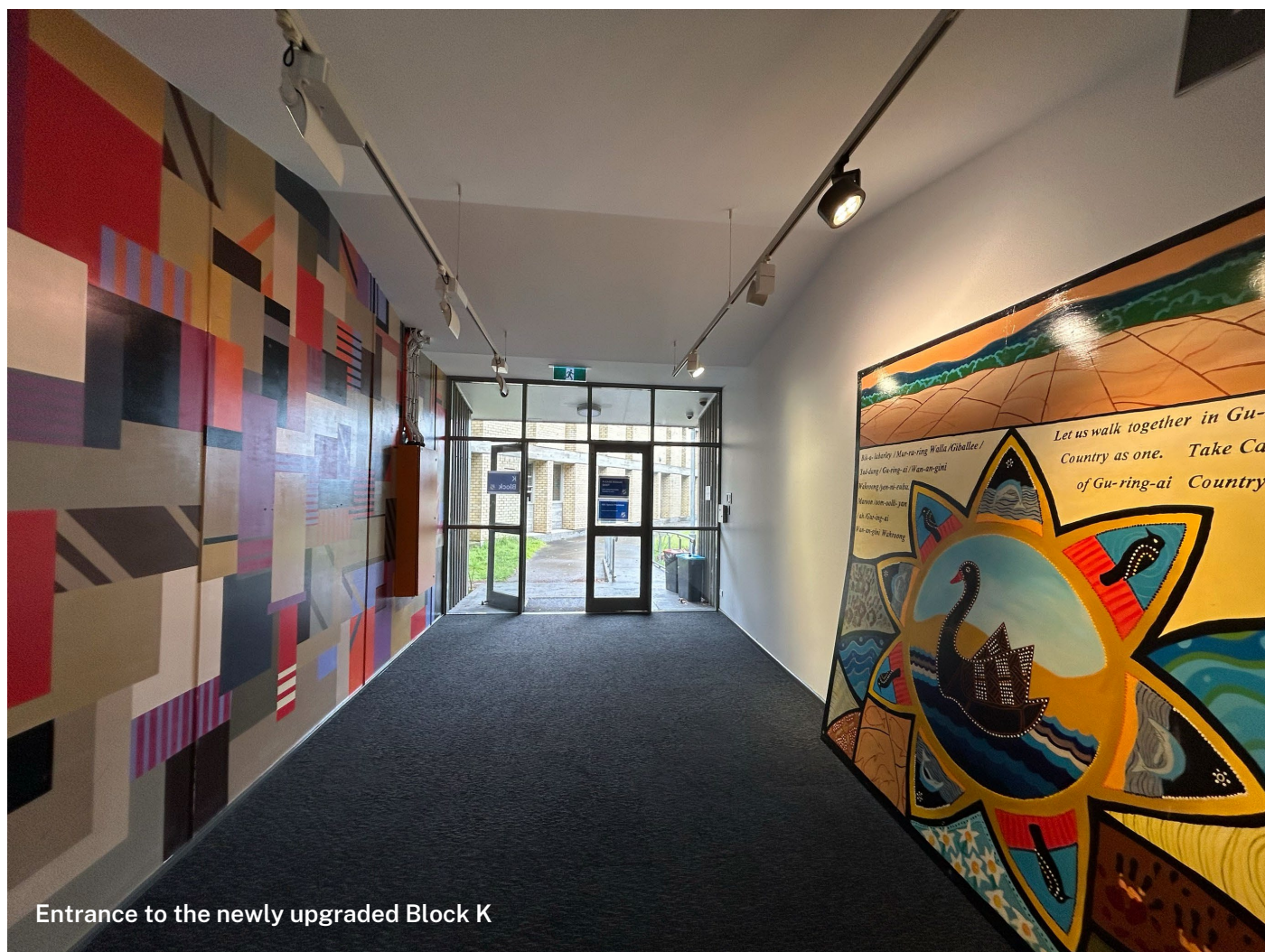
- Design of the internal refurbishment of Block C is expected to start in April 2024.
- Designs for the new science, technology, engineering and mathematics room, and upgraded woodwork, textile and computer rooms in Block A are finished. We expect to procure a contractor for these works by late-April 2024, after which construction will start.

Construction work hours

Construction work hours are Monday to Friday 7 am to 6 pm and Saturday 8 am to 1 pm. No work will be undertaken on Sunday or on public holidays unless otherwise advised.
