Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$8.9 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

We are delivering an upgrade to Narrabeen Sports High School. The next step in this project involves refurbishment of Block C and the remaining classrooms in Block K.

The project also includes completed upgrades to the technological and applied studies (TAS) classrooms and student and staff amenities in Block A, part of Block K, renewal of the science labs, prep rooms, and chemical storerooms in Block B, classrooms and amenities in Block E, amenities and change rooms in Block A and D and the replacement of roofs in Blocks B, C, D, and E, and part of Block A.

New performance hall

We are pleased to confirm that a new performance hall will be delivered in addition to the other upgrades to the school.

The performance hall will enable the school to hold assemblies and creative and performing arts events. The hall is expected to be completed in early 2027 and will feature:

- a raised stage area with back-of-house holding rooms, change rooms and stores
- multipurpose space for band rehearsals and creative and performing arts activities.

Complementing the hall, the Block K upgrade will include two acoustically treated music rooms and a smaller performance space with a sprung wooden floor to support dance and other creative arts subjects.

Progress summary

We have appointed engineers and BKA architects to design the new performance hall. The concept design is being finalised in consultation with the school.

New grass has been laid on the school's sports oval, which had been used by Narrabeen North Public School during construction, and the area has been returned to the high school to use.

Upgrades to 20 classrooms in Block C are also in progress, with final designs complete and the tender released.

Design work for the remainder of Block K, including the 2 music rooms and a performance space, is complete.

Next steps

- When the concept design for the performance hall is complete, we will share this with the community.
- The tenders for both the upgrade of the remainder of Block K and the upgrade of 20 classrooms in Block C, will be awarded in mid 2025, with construction to begin soon after.
- Work on Blocks K and C is expected to be completed in mid 2026.

We will keep you up to date as the project progresses.
