Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The upgrade of Neutral Bay Public School has been funded to deliver:

- 19 new flexible learning spaces
- improvements to the library, administration/staff areas, canteen, student amenities and storage facilities
- increased play space
- improved out of school hours care facilities.

Progress summary

The upgrade works detailed in Neutral Bay Public School's Development Application (DA) and submitted to North Sydney Council in late 2022 received community feedback while on public display. School Infrastructure NSW has carefully reviewed this feedback and adapted the plans for the upgrade works and is now required to resubmit the DA to Council.

Next steps
