

Neutral Bay Public School upgrade

Works notification | 28 August 2023

The upgrade of Neutral Bay Public School has been funded to deliver seven new flexible learning spaces and the refurbishment of 12 existing learning spaces. The project will also deliver a new library, canteen, student amenities, administration/staff facilities and storage rooms. Improvements to the school's out of hours care facilities and play spaces will also be provided.

Site remediation works

The removal of soil with asbestos containing material from the construction site is now complete. The soil has been taken to a licenced waste facility for safe disposal.

An independent hygienist has inspected the area and confirmed that it has been fully remediated. A clearance certificate has been issued to certify that the area is remediated, and construction can continue.

All air monitoring conducted onsite to date has returned results compliant with the National Occupational Health and Safety Commission guidelines.

The work was completed in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the site Remediation Action Plan. All work was completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors, and monitored by occupational hygienists in strict accordance with all applicable legislation, regulations, policies and guidelines.

Clean soil is currently being brought to site to replace the excavated soil. This work is now expected to finish by Friday, 8 September.
