Works notification | 7 December 2023

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, a project is underway to upgrade Neutral Bay Public School.

Concrete pours taking place on 11 December 2023

Construction of the new Building M is progressing. As part of this work, level one concrete pours will take place on **Monday 11 December 2023**. Should wet weather impact these works, pours will be scheduled for the following day.

What to expect

- Approximately 30 concrete trucks will travel to site to supply concrete.
- Pours will take place between 9:30 am and 2:30 pm. If there is a need to work past this time, the school will notify parents ahead of the afternoon pick-up.
- Traffic and pedestrian access will be maintained.
- Traffic control will be in place to help vehicles and pedestrians safely navigate the area while work is taking place.
- Noise levels are not expected to exceed those generated by regular construction activities.

Managing construction impacts

The safety of the school's students, staff, visitors and the local community is our highest priority. Construction planning is designed so there is minimal impact on school operations. Safety measures are in place to separate the construction site from areas occupied by the school and ensure students are unable to enter construction areas.
