Project update | October 2023

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$8.8 billion for new and upgraded schools. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

The NSW Government is upgrading Neutral Bay Public School to deliver 7 new flexible learning classrooms and refurbish 12 existing classrooms. The project will also deliver a new library, canteen, student amenities, staff facilities and storage rooms. Improvements to the school's out of hours care facilities and play spaces will also be provided.

Construction progress summary

Work on the Neutral Bay Public School upgrade project started in July 2023. Completed and ongoing activities include:

- Construction site has been established.
- Access path to Kindyland has been installed.
- Ongoing refurbishment of Building B, a heritage building that includes general learning spaces and out of school hours care facilities.
- Building I, which was also primarily used for out of school hours care, has been demolished.
- As part of the ongoing works to refurbish Building B, small amounts of bonded asbestos identified in the ceiling lining has been safely removed in accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and the NSW Department of Education's Asbestos Management Plan.

Upcoming works

Construction activities over the next 3 months will include:

- Laying the foundations for the new Building M. Work includes piling and constructing footings that will support the weight of the entire structure.
- Pouring of concrete slabs, which will see an increase of trucks coming to and from the site.
