### Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

### Project overview

The new high school will have contemporary facilities with flexible learning spaces for 450 students.

Learning spaces will be built to enable teaching of English, Mathematics, Science, Technologies, Human Society and its Environment (HSIE), Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE), Creative Arts, Languages, Food Technology and Agriculture.

As part of the high school project there will also be new facilities that can be made available for community use, additional local car parking and updated storage facilities for the 1st Bungendore Scout Group.

Bungendore Public School will also receive additional teaching spaces and an upgrade to its existing playing field with a new amenities block and field lighting.

The new high school will be open to years 7 and 8 for Day 1 Term 1 2023. The school will be operational in purpose built temporary facilities located at Bungendore Public School.

Temporary schools are flexible, modular spaces that help schools to operate while the planning and construction of permanent facilities is underway.

We thank the community for their patience as the important planning considerations, preparation work and design layout for the temporary school is undertaken.
