Bungendore High School

Works notification | 21 February 2023

Preparations are underway prior to the start of construction of Bungendore High School at its permanent location. The new high school will have modern facilities with 24 flexible learning spaces including three support learning spaces, a library, hall, school canteen, playing courts, an agricultural plot, and kiss and drop zones.

Learning spaces will be built to enable teaching of English, Mathematics, Science, Technologies, Human Society and its Environment (HSIE), Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE), Creative Arts, Languages, Vocational Education and Training (VET), and Agriculture.

Site establishment works

From Tuesday 28 February 2023, the contractor will start site establishment work in preparation for the main construction works to begin.

Site establishment includes installation of temporary construction fencing around the work site, installation of site accommodation such as the builder's site compound, and the removal of trees in accordance with the approved development.

Partial road closure and traffic changes on Majara Street

From Tuesday 28 February 2023, part of Majara Street will permanently close between Turallo Terrace and Gibraltar Street, in accordance with the approved development. Access to the Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council building will be maintained until 30 June 2023, with vehicle access from the intersection of Gibraltar and Majara streets. Access to the Bungendore Swimming Pool will also be maintained until the end of the swimming season (31 March 2023). Please see the site map on the following page for details.

Traffic control will be in place as required to manage pedestrian and vehicle movements near the site access points.




Figure 1: Map showing site establishment arrangements (indicative only).
