Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$7.9 billion over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 215 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Project overview

The new high school will have contemporary facilities with flexible learning spaces for 450 students.

Learning spaces will be built to enable teaching of English, Mathematics, Science, Technologies, Human Society and its Environment (HSIE), Personal Development, Health and Physical Education (PDHPE), Creative Arts, Languages, Vocational Education and Training (VET) and Agriculture.

As part of the high school project there will also be new facilities that can be made available for community use, additional local car parking and updated storage facilities for the scout hall.

Bungendore Public School will also receive additional teaching spaces and an upgrade to its existing playing field with a new amenities block and field lighting.

Acquisition of the new high school site completed

A key milestone has been achieved in the journey of Bungendore's new high school with the new high school site, located in the Majara and Gibraltar Streets precinct, having been transferred to the ownership of the Department of Education. This includes 2, 4, 6, and 10 Majara Street, part of the Majara Street Road Reserve (between Turallo Terrace and Gibraltar Street), a portion of Bungendore Park and a part of Turallo Terrace Reserve for use as the 'Ag Plot'.

The acquisition includes the existing Council buildings, the community centre, a portion of the swimming pool location, and a small portion of Mick Sherd Oval. The Department will continue to work with Queanbeyan-Palerang Regional Council regarding arrangements for the existing Council facilities and to ensure a smooth transition to construction works, once the State Significant Development Application has been determined.
