School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) is planning to deliver a new high school in Edmondson Park. The high school will include fit-for-purpose classrooms and core facilities to meet enrolment demand in Edmondson Park and support the growing opulation in South-West Sydney.

Progress update

We have lodged a request for the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) with the Department of Planning and Environment. The SEARs advise a range of environmental, planning, and social considerations that need to be undertaken as part of the Environmental Impact Statement for the State Significant Development application.

An early concept design has been developed for the new high school which will ultimately accommodate up to 2000 students. The delivery program is subject to NSW Treasury and planning approvals, however, plans are underway to deliver approximately 40 learning spaces for up to 800 students by 2027.

In April 2023, a business case was submitted to NSW Treasury for approval to progress to project delivery.
