## Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

## What the new permanent high school will deliver

Construction has begun on the new permanent school, which will have 25 flexible learning spaces including three support learning spaces, to accommodate approximately 500 students. It will also deliver:

- a library, multi-purpose hall and covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- sports courts and outdoor spaces
- administration facilities and a canteen.

## Progress update: the new permanent high school at Jerrabomberra

The site for the new permanent high school has been established and earthmoving works are underway.

- Concrete pouring, to establish the foundations for the school buildings, has started and the slab for the sports hall has been completed. The slabs for the classrooms and administration buildings, which include the library, are also likely to be complete by early December.
- Delivery and assembly of structural steel frames, precast panels and scaffolding in addition to the building of a retaining wall for the school library, has also begun and will continue into January 2023.
- Despite the wet weather, the building work is on schedule, and the construction team are focussed on delivering the new Jerrabomberra High School in the shortest possible timeframe.

### Progress update: the temporary high school

Work started on installing temporary school buildings at Jerrabomberra in September.

These buildings will be open to welcome new students in Years 7 and 8 from Day 1 Term 1 2023 in purpose built temporary facilities located on the Jerrabomberra Public School site.

Temporary schools are flexible, modular spaces that help schools to operate while the planning and construction of permanent facilities is underway.

Almost all of the temporary buildings are now in place at Jerrabomberra Public School with service connections and construction of walkways underway.

### Next steps for the temporary high school

In the coming weeks the final buildings will be delivered, equipment will be installed, and furniture will be placed inside ready for Day 1 Term 1 2023.

### A message from the founding principal

With many of the teachers and support staff now on board for our new high school - and much of the temporary school now taking shape - we're gearing up to welcome our new Year 7 and 8 students for the first day of term.

The construction of our shiny new permanent Jerrabomberra High School continues apace, and we look forward to seeing it take shape over the coming months.
