

Jerrabomberra High School

Works notification

27 September 2022

Construction has started for the new high school in Jerrabomberra. The new high school will have modern facilities, with 25 flexible learning spaces including three support learning spaces, to accommodate approximately 500 students and will deliver:

- library
- multi-purpose hall
- sports courts
- covered outdoor learning area
- outdoor space
- canteen
- administration facilities.

Jerrabomberra High School next steps

The site has been established and earthmoving works are underway.

Concrete pouring, to establish the foundations for the school buildings, will start in early October and continue for most of the month. Delivery and assembly of structural steel frames, in addition to building of a retaining wall for the school library, will also begin.

As part of these works, trucks, excavators, and a crane will be onsite. Traffic controllers will guide vehicles onto the site and prioritise pedestrian safety when required.

There will be no changes to traffic in the area, and we don't expect traffic on Environa Drive to be affected.

Working hours

These works will be confined to the approved working hours, which are between 7 am and 6 pm on Mondays to Fridays, and 8 am and 1 pm on Saturdays. Works may also be undertaken between 6 pm and 7 pm Mondays to Fridays and between 1 pm and 4 pm, Saturdays provided noise levels do not exceed the existing background noise level by more than 5 decibels.
