

# Jerrabomberra High School Project update | May 2023

### **Project overview**

Jerrabomberra High School opened on Day 1 Term 1 2023 in purpose built temporary facilities located at Jerrabomberra Public School. Construction of the new permanent high school is underway. It will have modern facilities, with 25 flexible learning spaces including 3 support learning spaces, to accommodate approximately 500 students. It will deliver a library, multi-purpose hall, canteen, sports courts, covered outdoor learning area (COLA), outdoor space and administration facilities.

## **Progress update**

The design changes to incorporate an additional science laboratory have been finalised and will be lodged with the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) as a modification to the State Significant Development Application. Following approval of the modification from DPE, both science laboratories will be located on the first floor of Block B, which also houses a staff study and lounge and General Learning Space (GLS). The image below shows the location of the science laboratories. Please refer to the Project Update – February 2023 to see the layout of the rest of the school.
