Project update

June 2022

Investing in our schools

A project is underway to deliver a new primary school for the Murrumbateman community. The new school will include flexible learning spaces, a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), library and hall, and will cater for up to 370 students.

The project is being fast-tracked as part of the NSW Government's \$3 billion Jobs and Infrastructure Acceleration Fund, and is being built using Modern Methods of Construction (MMC).

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Progress summary

Works commenced on site in early 2022, and have been progressing well despite impacts from poor weather.

- Building modules have been constructed off site in a purpose-built factory.
- Concrete footings and slab works have been completed for most buildings.
- Structural steel framing is underway, and roofing and wall cladding has begun.
- In-ground services have been installed and electrical works have started.

Next steps

- Delivery and installation of the off-site manufactured modules will commence from 21 June 2022.
- Site works will continue to complete floor slabs, roofing, and external cladding.
- Building works to install building services, and install internal fitout elements.
- External works including paths, play spaces, walkways and landscaping will begin.
