

Murrumbateman Public School

Works notification

14⁵ June 2022

A project is underway to deliver a new primary school for the Murrumbateman community. The new school will include flexible learning spaces, a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), library and hall, and will cater for up to 370 students.

Over the past few months, while works on site have progressed, some school buildings have also been manufactured off-site in a purpose-built factory, utilising modern methods of construction. Construction of the building modules is complete, and modules are ready to be delivered and installed on site.

Delivery of building modules from Tuesday 21 June 2022

On Tuesday 21 June 2022 there will be changes to traffic surrounding the school site to facilitate the delivery and installation of building modules, weather and site conditions permitting. A crane will be arriving onsite on Monday 20 June 2022 to enable delivery and placement of the building modules.

- A stop/go traffic controller will be in place on Fairley Street to facilitate truck entry and exit to the school site.
- Access to residential properties will be maintained under traffic control.
- For the safety of the local community and workers, road users are advised to obey directions.

We will provide further notification if these works need to be rescheduled. The delivery of the building modules will be carried out over the following 3 weeks.

Working hours

Traffic control set up will start from 6:30am on Tuesday 21 June 2022. Standard project working hours are 7am to 5pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays.
