Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Building is on track for opening on Day 1 Term 1 2023:

Works began on site in early 2022 and are going well. The contractor has:

- constructed the external walls and roof, including fitting of the door and window frames, in the administration and library building (Building A)
- installed the modular classroom buildings (Buildings B and C)
- completed the external walls and roof of the canteen and hall building (Building D).

Next steps

In the coming months, the contractor will:

- finalise the internal works for the administration and library, and the canteen and hall
- continue with the internal fit out of the classroom buildings
- progress the external works including the walkways, landscaping, and the kiss and ride/existing car park upgrade
- upgrade the power supply to the school – this may involve a power outage. If you are likely to be affected, you will be notified well in advance by the Department of Education and Essential Energy.

When will Murrumbateman Primary School open?

Murrumbateman Public School will open on Day 1 Term 1 2023.

What's the capacity of Murrumbateman Public School?

Once built, the school will have capacity to enrol 370 students from Kindergarten to Year 6.

When will construction be complete?

We expect all construction work to be completed by early 2023.

Will there be Out of Hours School Care (OHSC) available?

Yes, there will be Out of Hours school care available. The provider will be announced soon. Please check the school's website murrumbateman-p.schools.nsw.gov.au for updates.

Are the teaching spaces air-conditioned?

Yes, all teaching spaces will be air-conditioned.

Can I enrol my child at Murrumbateman Public School?
