# Murrumbateman Public School

Project update | September 2022

## Investing in our schools

A project is underway to deliver a new primary school for the Murrumbateman community. The new school will include flexible learning spaces, a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), library and hall, and will cater for up to 370 students. The project is being fast-tracked as part of the NSW Government's \$3 billion Jobs and Infrastructure Acceleration Fund, and is being built using Modern Methods of Construction (MMC).

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

## **Progress summary**

Works began on site in early 2022, and have been progressing well despite some weather impacts. The contractor has:

- constructed the external walls and roof, including fitting of the door and window frames, in the administration and library building (Building A)
- installed the modular classroom buildings (Buildings B and C)
- completed the external walls and roof of the canteen and hall building (Building D).

## **Next steps**

In the coming months, the contractor will:

- finalise the internal works for the administration and library, and the canteen and hall
- continue with the internal fit out of the classroom buildings
- progress the external works including the walkways, landscaping, and the kiss and ride/existing car park upgrade.


