Student update

As you might be aware, Newcastle East Public School is currently experiencing low student attendance. All classrooms have been relocated to the new building, library and demountables. No students or teachers are present in the heritage building.

The out of school hours care (OOSH) have been relocated to the new canteen space, the covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and in wet weather, the library.

New Building (Building E)

The new lift contractor is on site finishing the testing and commissioning of the new lift. This should be complete by mid-April. We will also continue fixing defects.

Heritage building

Work will continue next for the Heritage building and will include refurbishing the administration area, slating of the roof tiles over the two previously occupied classrooms and guttering, downpipes and gable and eave restoration works.

We will also start to refurbish the three chimneys and this will require changes to both internal and external scaffolding.

Work hours are 7:00am to 5:00pm Monday to Saturday and 8:00am to 4:00pm on Sundays.

Playground remediation

We are continuing to finalise the detailed design for the playground remediation work in preparation for tendering and procurement of services.
