# **Newcastle Education Campus** Works notification | 10 November 2023

Located on the main Newcastle High School site, the Newcastle Education Campus will cater for the growing population in the region by delivering: 37 new permanent learning spaces; 5 new support learning spaces; and a new library, multi-purpose facility (hall), canteen and science laboratories.

## Demountable installation from 13 November 2023

As part of preparations for the upgrade of Newcastle High School, 11 additional temporary classrooms and 2 amenity blocks will be installed within the school boundary, and 1 existing demountable will be removed (please see map overleaf).

Once installed, all teaching facilities from Building B will move into the temporary buildings and other areas of the school. This means Building B can be demolished to make way for the new learning hub without impacting school lessons.

From Monday 13 November our contractor will start preparing the site for the demountables, which includes installing temporary fencing, digging service trenches and constructing pier foundations.

The new demountables will be delivered to the site from Monday 27 November. Delivery will be via the teachers' car park off Smith Street. The temporary demountable, known as Building Q, will be removed from the school grounds via National Park Street.

#### **Traffic management**

Traffic controllers will be used where required for the safety of students, staff and the local community. Please follow the directions of any temporary signage and traffic controllers when in place. Large vehicle movements will be scheduled outside of peak school drop off and pick up times, where feasible.

## Work hours

Work will be completed during standard construction hours from Monday to Friday between 7:00 am and 5:00 pm, and on Saturdays between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm. The works are expected to take 8 weeks to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

All work will take place within the school grounds and will be coordinated with the school to avoid any impact on student learning.
