

# Newcastle High School

## Works notification | 2 October 2024

The Newcastle High School redevelopment will cater for the growing population in the region by delivering 37 new classrooms, 5 new support learning spaces, a new library, multi-purpose facility, a canteen and science laboratories.

### Foundation and Structural Works

Construction of the new learning hub and multi-purpose facility is progressing. In recent weeks earthworks have occurred in preparation for foundation and structural works.

#### What to expect

- Use of heavy machinery such as excavators and specialised equipment to install piles and rammer compactors may cause noise and vibrations to be felt within 100m of the construction site.
- Construction activity will adhere to the recommended safe working distances outlined in the Construction Noise and Vibration Management Plan, accessible on the project webpage (link below).

### Concrete pours

As part of this work, concrete pours will take place from October 2024 until January 2025.

#### What to expect

- Concrete trucks will travel to and from the site for the construction of foundations, slabs, columns, stairs, walkways, lift shaft components, external footpaths and planter beds.
- Trucks will enter the construction site through the National Park Street and Smith Street contractor entrances. See map overleaf.
- Traffic control will be in place at both site entrances to maintain traffic flow and pedestrian safety.

### Work hours

All works will take place in standard construction hours, which are Monday to Friday, between 7 am to 6 pm and Saturdays between 8 am and 1 pm as per the development application (DA) consent conditions.
