Nirimba Fields Public School

Project update | September 2023

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$3.5 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Planning for the permanent Nirimba Fields Public School underway. In the short term, a purpose-built temporary primary school will be built to cater for Kindergarten to Year 6 students. The temporary school will be located at the corner of Triton Parade and Nabthorpe Parade, Nirimba Fields. It will be established along the southern boundary, occupying approximately 40% of the site, which will allow for the future construction of the permanent school.

Progress summary

The development application (DA) to build the temporary Nirimba Fields Public School was approved by Blacktown City Council in September 2023. This allows construction to begin on site.

Thank you to the parents, guardians and community members who visited our information sessions to meet our new School Principal, Renai Diamond, participated in our values survey and provided input with our logo and uniform design.

We are accepting enrolments for Day 1 Term 1 2024. You can access the enrolment page for the school by going to the school webpage at nirimbafields-p.schools.nsw.gov.au or scanning the QR code. Next steps

- Placement of foundations in the area where the temporary buildings will be located.
- Digging service trenches to lay data fibres, conduits and electrical cabling.
- Recruit executive teaching staff.

Project benefits

The permanent school will accommodate 1000 students and will include:

- modern classrooms and support learning classrooms
- multipurpose hall for sports and performance
- a library, canteen and administration facilities
- covered outdoor learning area (COLA)

The temporary school will accommodate 419 students and will include:

- classrooms
- a library, canteen and administration facilities
- dedicated toilets
- on-site parking
