Nirimba Fields Public School Works notification | 5 June 2024

A project is underway to deliver the new Nirimba Fields Public School to meet the current population needs and future enrolment growth. In the short term, a purpose-built temporary primary school opened on Day 1 Term 1 2024 for Kindergarten to Year 6 on the southern border of the permanent school site, located at the corner of Triton Parade and Nabthorpe Parade, Nirimba Fields.

Restoring the permanent school site

Work has started to restore the permanent school site to its original condition by removing stockpiles of soil that were moved during the construction of the temporary school facilities.

These works are expected to finish in the week starting 17 June 2024, weather permitting.

The area is fenced off and will remain out of bounds to students and staff. Any work that may create moderate dust levels will not take place on windy days or during times when students are outside, such as during recess and lunch breaks.

The health, safety, and wellbeing of the school and the local community are our highest priority, and we will minimise impacts on the community at every opportunity.

Working hours

Working hours are 7 am to 4 pm Monday to Friday and 8 am to 4 pm on Saturday. No work will take place on Sundays or public holidays. The community will be notified if any works outside of these hours are required.
