Power restored

North Sydney Public School has its permanent electricity source restored, as works to repair the school's damaged powerlines were completed on Saturday, 7 May 2022.

Works to remediate the small trench dug between the McHatton and River buildings, which was required to reroute powerlines to the River Building have also been completed. This area has been checked for safety and the play space returned to students.

With the school's power now restored, the generator and its safety fencing have been removed from the staff car park.
