Works notification

21 November 2022

Dear residents, parents and carers,

As part of the upgrade of North Sydney Public School, works to remove asbestos containing materials in the ceiling of the Pacific building's student amenities are required before renovation works can start.

This work will take place out of school hours on Saturday 26 November 2022 and will be completed in one day.

Safety measures will be in place to ensure there is no risk to students, staff or the local community. This includes enclosing the amenities with plastic sheeting while the removal works take place and installing air monitors. Onsite contractors will also wear protective clothing including face masks, coveralls, gloves and footwear.

The work will be completed by licensed and accredited asbestos contractors and monitored by an independent occupational hygienist in strict accordance with SafeWork NSW regulations and a project-specific asbestos management plan.

The amenities will be inspected to ensure they are fully remediated and a clearance certificate will be issued before the renovation works start.

Please be assured the removal of this material does not pose a risk to students, school staff or the community.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is School Infrastructures NSW's highest priority and we will continue to keep the community updated.

Renovation works

Renovation works will start in the Pacific building's student amenities from Monday 28 November 2022. The amenities will be closed until early 2023 while the works are carried out.
