## Noisy works – from 23 August to 25 August 2023

The new buildings I and J are almost finished. In order for concrete to be poured for a new set of stairs to the new buildings, the contractor needs to remove some tree stumps. This will involve grinding works which are expected to be noisy.

The grinding works will take place between Wednesday 23 August and Friday 25 August 2023. We are working closely with the Principal to ensure that the noisy works have minimal impacts to school operations.

If the stump grinding is unable to be finished during this time due to inclement weather, it is possible it may take place in the following days.

## Changes to hoarding – from 19 August 2023

To prepare for the new buildings I and J opening, the contractor needs to make some changes to the site boundaries so that external works can be finished.

From Saturday 19 August 2023, temporary shade cloth fencing will be installed approximately 1 metre parallel to the existing timber hoarding. The temporary fencing will be installed on the school side of the hoarding.

From Monday 21 August to Friday 25 August 2023, the existing timber hoarding will be dismantled and removed. Work to remove the hoarding will be from the construction site side, rather than the school side.

The temporary access route through the school grounds will remain operational whilst these hoarding changes take place.
