## Out of hours work – from 29 July 2023 to 27 August 2023

The new buildings I and J are progressing well. In order for the new buildings to be ready for the school to use as soon as possible, there will be out of hours work required on the following dates and times:

- Saturday 26 August 2023, 7 am to 8 am and 1 pm to 4 pm
- Sunday 27 August 2023, 7 am to 4 pm.

In accordance with our conditions of consent, the works undertaken out of hours will be inaudible to the nearest sensitive receivers. They include internal painting and finishes, landscaping works and minor façade works.

## New access route into construction zone – from 1 August 2023

The new buildings I and J are progressing well and are currently expected to be finished later in term 3 2023. To prepare for the new buildings opening, the contractor needs to put in a new access route into the construction zone from 1 August 2023.

The new access route will be from McHatton Street and go between the River Building and the McHatton Building into the construction zone. This new access route will facilitate external works to be finished, and block H to be removed.

Staff and students will be able to use the pathway to move through the school during school hours. The path will be closed for short periods of time as required when there are construction vehicle movements. During school hours, any construction vehicle movements will be escorted with a dedicated traffic control spotter. There will be no construction vehicle movements during recess or lunchtime.

The health, safety, and well-being of the school and the local community is the Department of Education's highest priority. We thank you for your cooperation during this important work.
