Works notification | 4 July 2023

Road works taking place on Bay Road between 5 July and 15 July 2023

As part of the project to upgrade North Sydney Public School, road works are required to take place during the school holidays, between Wednesday 5 July and Saturday 15 July 2023. All works will take place during approved construction hours between 7 am and 5 pm.

The work involves opening the road to put in a plumbing connection, to connect the new school buildings to the existing water main. A trench will need to be dug in the road and footpath for the water connections to be made.

Traffic control will be in place to help vehicles and pedestrians safely navigate the area while work is taking place. Parking will be removed on either side of the street while work is underway, and an alternating traffic flow for vehicles will be set up. Please refer to the map below for more detail.

We expect that this work may generate some noise due to the use of an excavator, and some dust may be generated during the trenching work.
