North Sydney Public School upgrade project includes the upgrade and delivery of new facilities to provide for growing student enrolments in the area. The project is delivered over three construction stages with separate occupation dates. The scope of the project over three stages is outlined below:

Building G fit-out.

#### Stage 2

- Demolition works.
- New Buildings I & J.
- · Landscaping.

Stage 3 (Subject to MOD 3 approval)

• Further landscaping works.

The Stage 1 of the project was completed in September 2022, with the school taking occupation of the Stage 1 facilities that same month.
