Noise and dust control measures have been implemented to meet the project's planning approval requirements and to ensure school activities are not disrupted. Dust from construction works is being watered down as required.  A small number of trees located on Bay Road were removed to accommodate the new buildings. Approval to remove these trees was obtained as part of the project's State Significant Development Application.
