Planning update | February 2025

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

Planning for an upgrade to Nowra East Public School is currently underway and will focus on providing additional permanent teaching space capacity to replace demountables, including

- new permanent classrooms
- additional support teaching facilities
- expansion of preschool capacity.

Progress summary

The project team are currently working on masterplan options.

Engagement is underway with key stakeholders, including staff from Nowra East Public School, to help determine the designs. A project reference group (PRG) has been established, and regular meetings are being held.

Next steps

The project team is working with architects and other specialists to develop the designs for the upgrade.
