

New High School for Flinders

Project update | June 2026

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.3 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

This new high school will support the growing needs of the Flinders and Shell Cove communities in the Illawarra and allow families to access educational facilities close to home. The new school is part of the NSW Government's work to accommodate the significant growth, development, and anticipated enrolments within the local area.

The new high school will be located adjacent to Flinders Public School, cater for 750 students and will open Day 1 Term 1 2029. It will include:

- 33 classrooms
- 3 support classrooms
- specialist workshops for science, wood and metal work
- library
- administration facilities
- covered outdoor learning area (COLA) and canteen
- multipurpose hall for performance and sports
- sports courts, playing field and landscaping.

- hold a community information session to view plans and learn more about the project
- finalise and lodge planning pathway documents ahead of public exhibition.
