

Consultation – New high school for Gledswood Hills and Gregory Hills

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild essential services, the 2023-24 Budget is delivering a record \$3.5 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment in growing communities will ensure working families get access to a world class public education.

Planning is underway for a new high school for Gledswood Hills and Gregory Hills. In the short term, a purpose built temporary high school will open for Year 7 students in 2025. It will be located at Gregory Hills Public School.

The permanent high school due to open Day 1 Term 1 2027 will include:

- modern classrooms and specialist support classrooms
- a multi-purpose hall for sports and performance, sports and recreation facilities
- a covered outdoor learning area (COLA), a library, canteen and administration facilities.

The temporary high school will accommodate up to 150 Year 7 students in 2025 and up to 300 students in 2026 (accommodating Year 7 and 8 students) and will include:

- general classrooms
- specialist classrooms for science, wood and metal workshops, food technology, music and visual arts
- a library and administration facilities
- dedicated toilets and change rooms.
