Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$1.4 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world-class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new high school for the growing community in Googong. This is in addition to the expanded high school for Jerrabomberra and new high school for Bungendore. The new high school will include:

- modern classrooms and specialist support classes
- a multipurpose hall for sports and performance
- specialist classrooms for science, wood and metal workshops, performing arts and hospitality
- sports and recreation facilities
- a library, canteen, administration facilities and parking.

Progress summary

The master plan is complete which determines the location of the new high school buildings. The team is now completing the schematic design which will detail the form of buildings and functionality of internal spaces. The designs have been worked on in consultation with architects and the Project Reference Group (PRG) which includes representatives from the community and educational leadership in the region.

The project team have engaged specialist disciplines to complete investigations to learn about the site conditions. This includes geotechnical investigations with a boring rig which is currently in progress.

Construction tender release

We are pleased to confirm the construction tender to appoint a building contractor for the project has been released. Over the coming months we will review tender submissions and award the



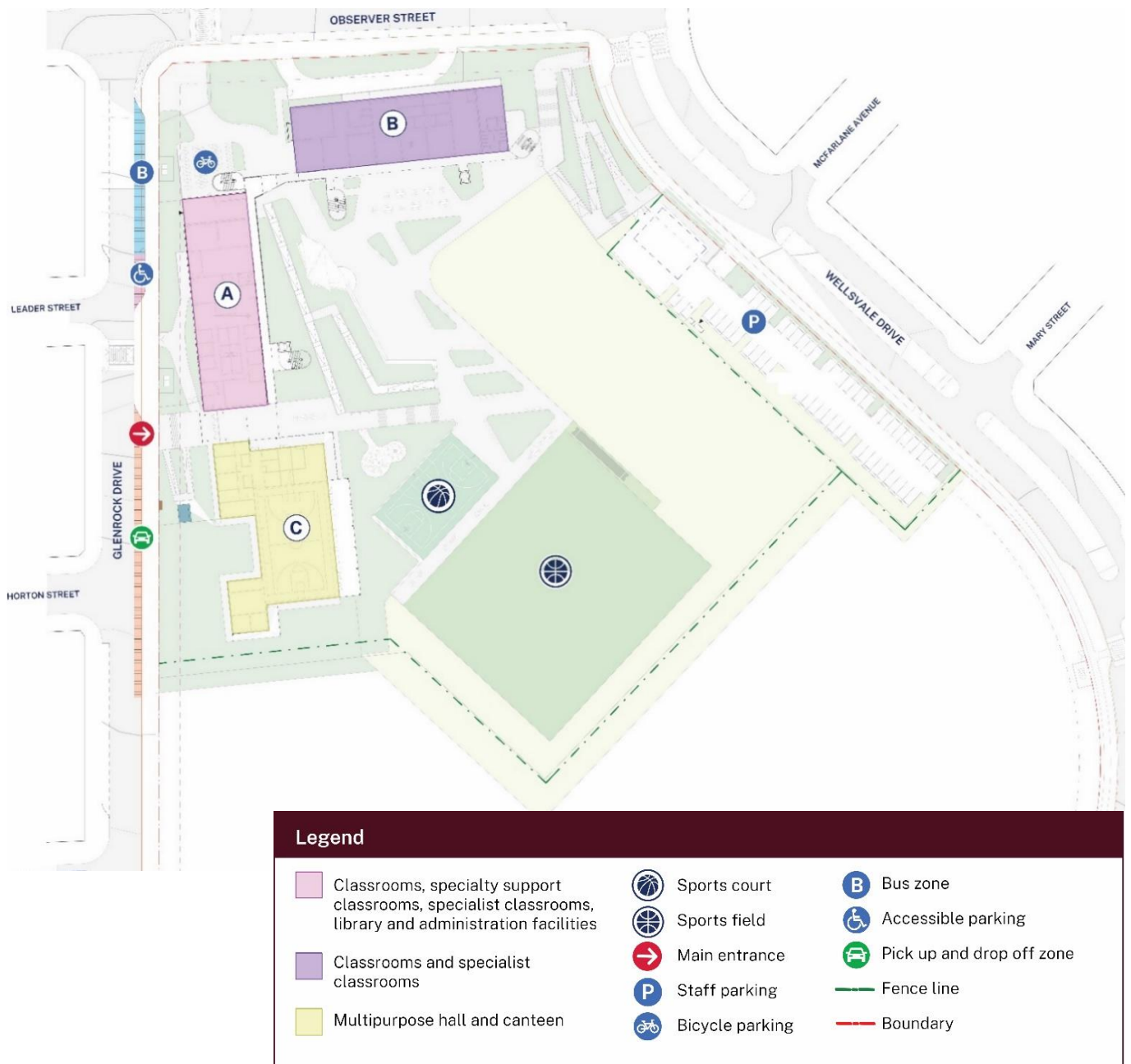

building contract. The appointed contractor will advance the design of the new building to prepare for construction.

Next steps

- Complete the tender process and award the construction contract.
- Share schematic designs with community at an information session in early 2025.
- Continue the statutory planning process. This will tell us what specialist reports we will need to prepare to inform the planning application for the project. These reports will be available for community review once the planning application is on public exhibition.
