

# New high school at Pottsville

## Planning update | December 2025

### Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

### Project overview

The NSW Government is planning for a new high school in Pottsville.

As part of the planning process, the department has carried out a detailed review of current and projected enrolment demand, planned development and other considerations that will inform the development of the future school.

### New high school site

After an extensive search for suitable sites, we have identified a location for the new high school on Seabreeze Boulevard, Pottsville. We are currently in the process of acquiring the land for the new school. This involves a compulsory acquisition process, as outlined under the *Land Acquisition (Just Terms Compensation) Act 1991*. A map of the new school site is on the next page.

The preferred school site is earmarked for a high school in the Tweed Council Development Control Plan, with good access to main connecting roads, footpaths, housing and community infrastructure.

Several alternative sites were explored however the final site was considered the most suitable for the development of a school due to environmental and associated road and pedestrian access benefits.
