

New schools in the Box Hill area

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

As part of this investment, planning work is well underway to deliver a new public preschool, primary school and high school for Box Hill and a new public preschool and primary school for Gables.

To ensure that local families can send their children to a local public school sooner, Box Hill Public School will be delivered in purpose built temporary facilities on George Street, Box Hill with the goal of opening in early 2025.

Box Hill Public School intake area for early 2025

In 2025, a shared intake area will be in place for Rouse Hill and Box Hill Public Schools where students can be considered for both schools.

Families living in the shared intake area can continue to enrol their children at Rouse Hill Public School, and will continue to be guaranteed a place.

Families who wish to enrol their children at Rouse Hill Public School can continue to do so, and families within the intake area will be guaranteed a place at the school.

Additionally, families living in the shared intake area can submit an expression of interest to enrol their children at Box Hill Public School. The community will be notified when the EOI opens in the coming weeks.

In the event that our goal of opening by Term 1 2025 cannot be achieved, all students are guaranteed a place at Rouse Hill Public School.

Box Hill Public School intake area for early 2025

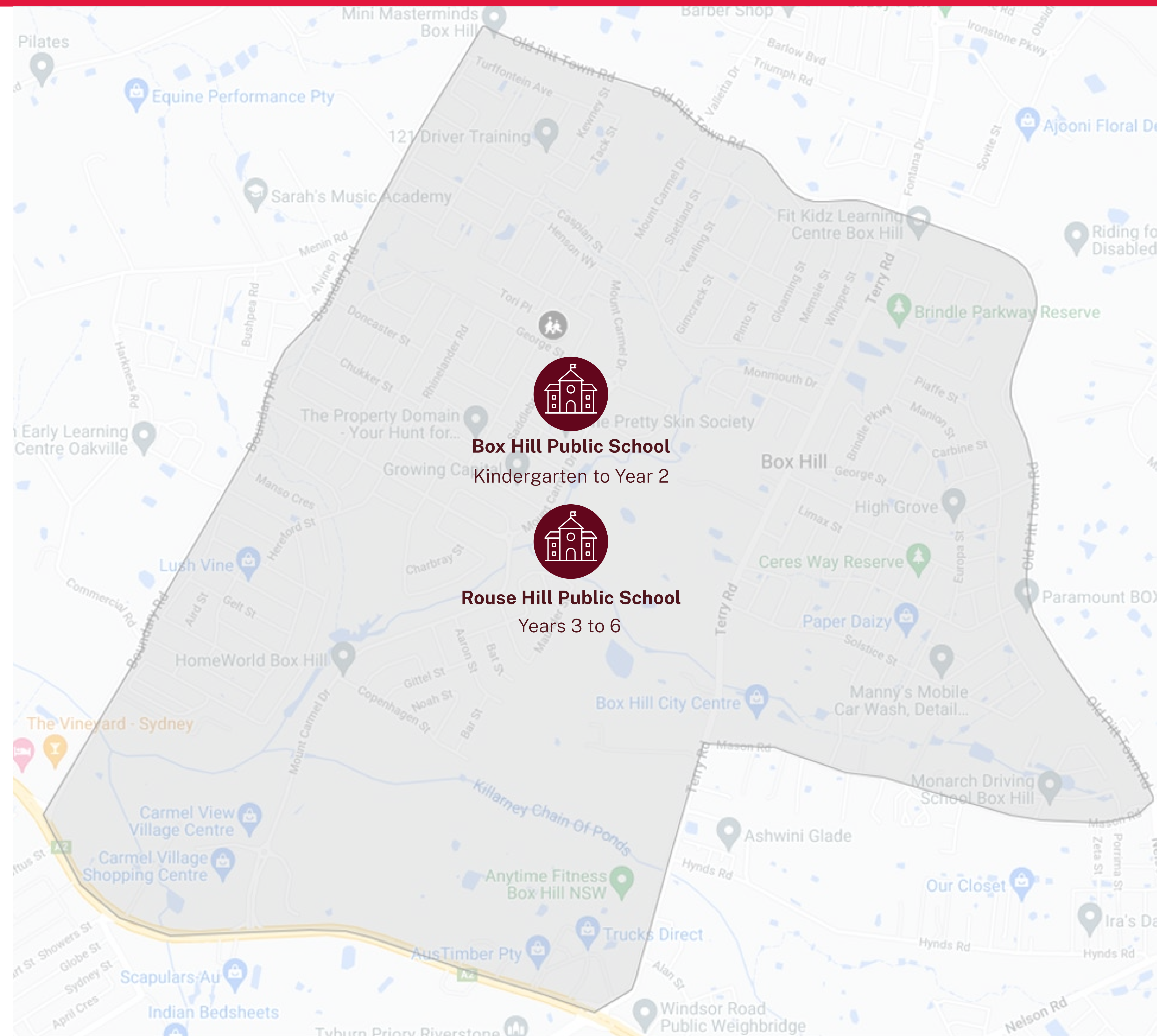
During this initial stage, the intake area for Box Hill Public School will be shared with the intake area for Rouse Hill Public School.

School boundaries for this stage will be

- Boundary Road to the west
- Old Pitt Town Road to the north
- Old Pitt Town Road and Terry Road to the east
- Mason Road and Windsor Road to the south

We understand that not everyone's circumstances are the same, and that there are instances where exceptional and compelling circumstances will need to be considered. If this is the case, you should talk to the Principal of your local school.

Non-local enrolment applications for children living outside of the proposed intake areas will be considered on a case-by-case basis in line with the department's enrolment policy.

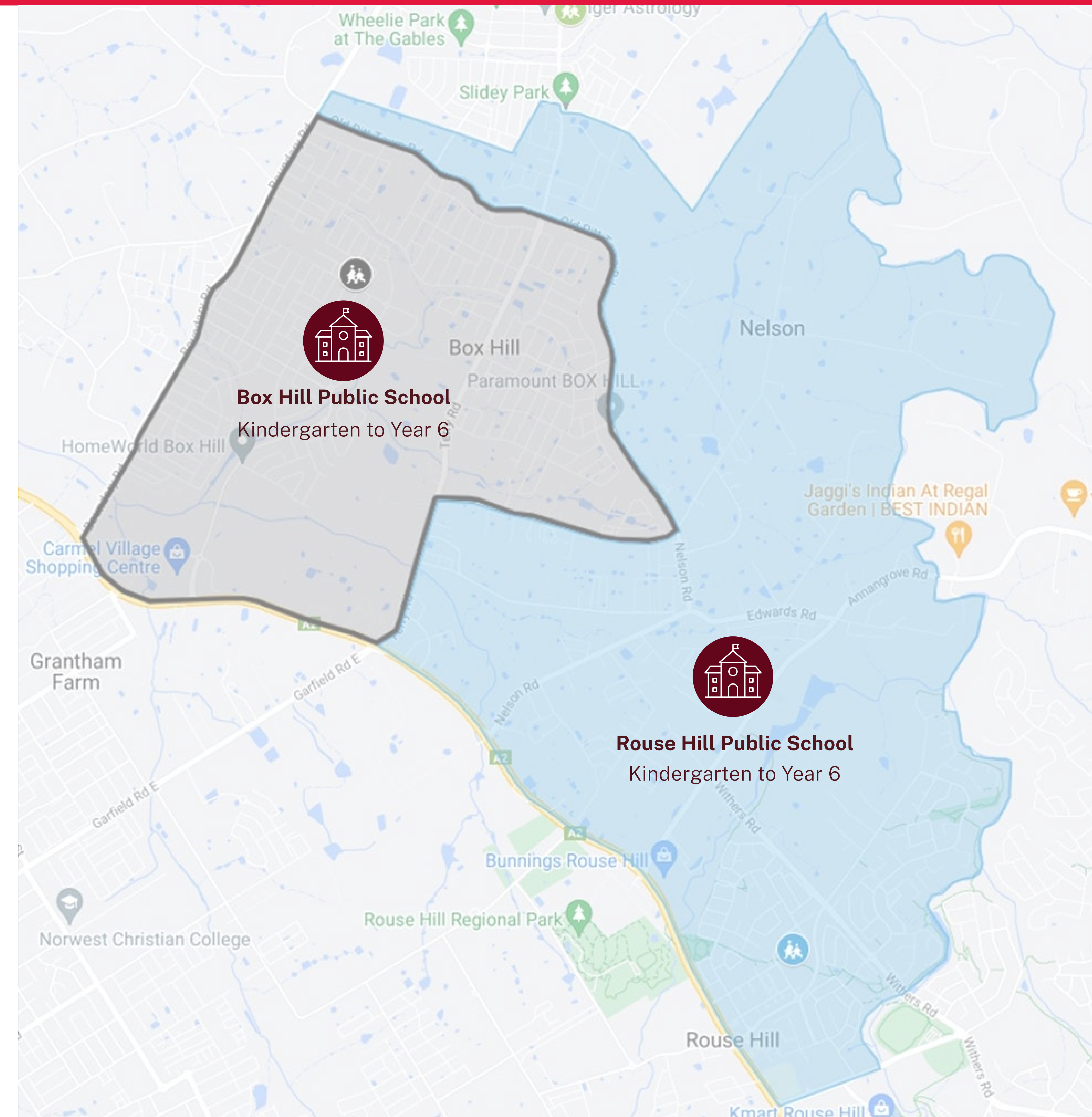


Box Hill Public School intake area for Term 3 2025

In Term 3 2025, Box Hill Public School will open to all Years from Kindergarten to Year 6.

All enrolment applications will be considered in line with the Department of Education's Enrolment Policy which will give preference to families living close to the school and consider families unique circumstances wherever possible.

Temporary schools

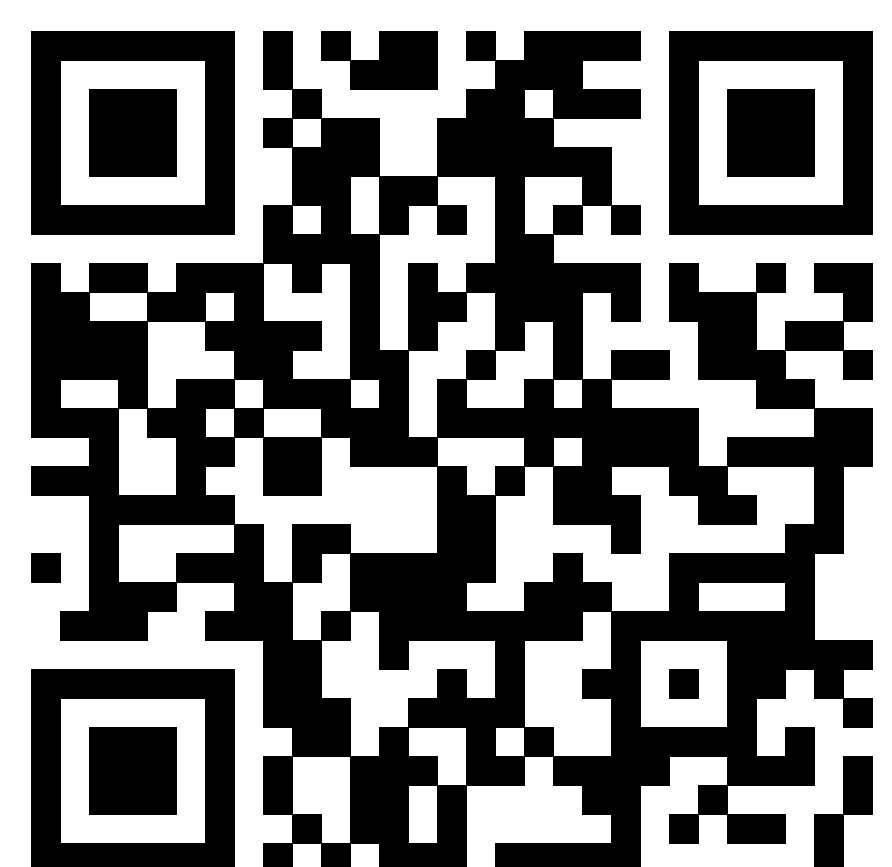
Temporary schools are flexible, modular spaces that help schools to operate while the planning and construction of permanent facilities is underway.

Temporary schools

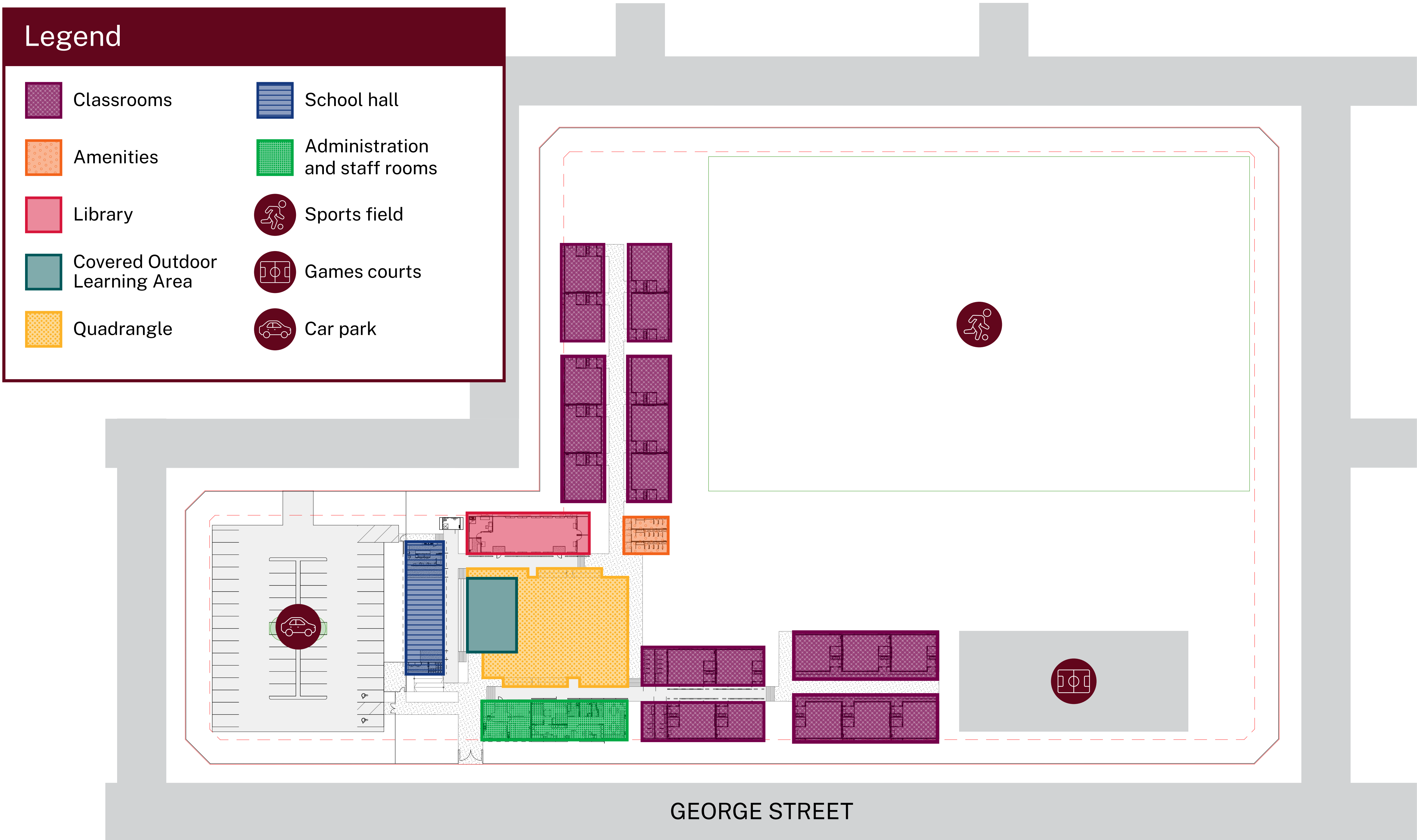
The temporary facilities for Box Hill Public School will include:

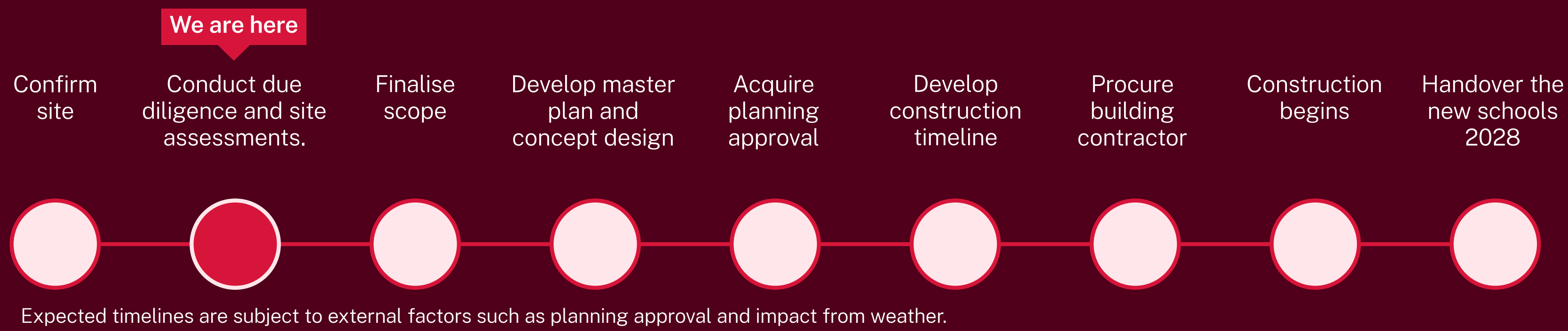

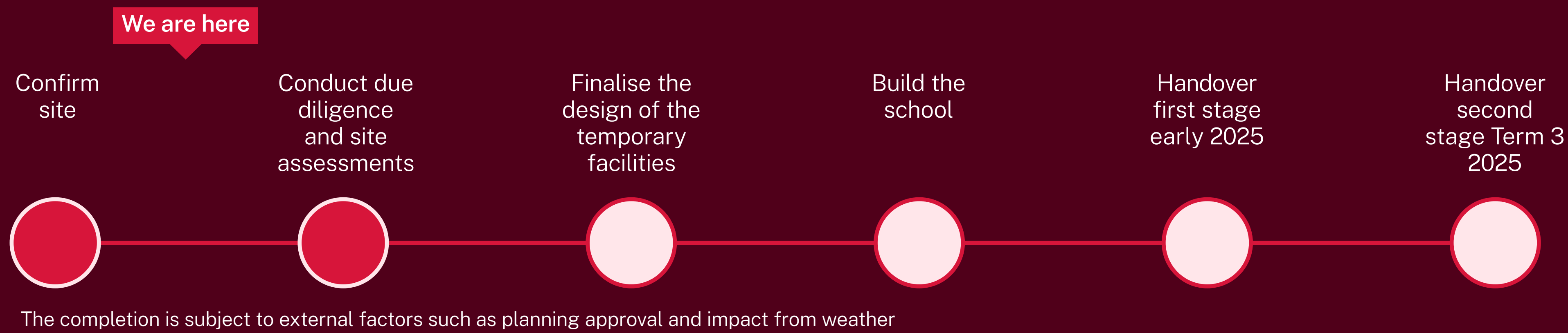


Box Hill Public School and High School

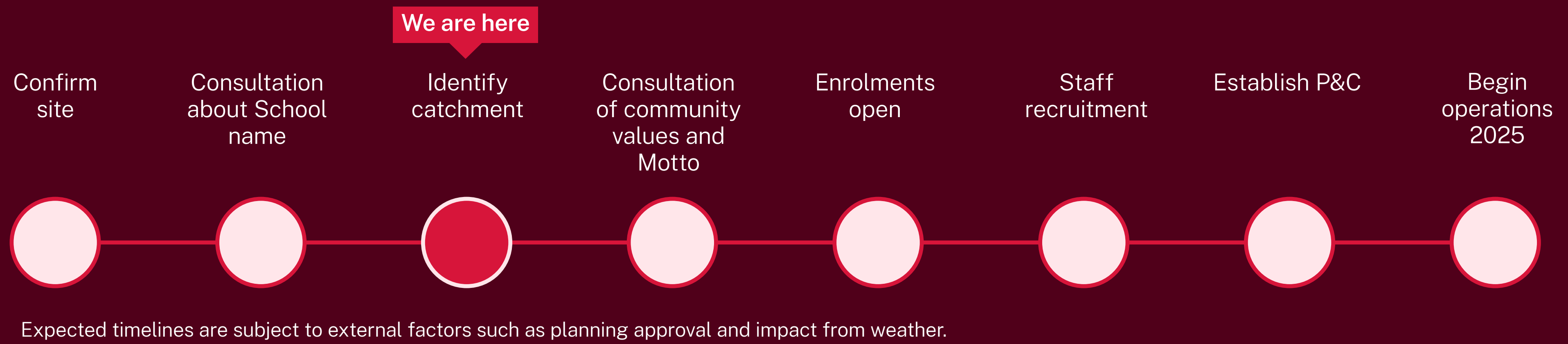
The timeline below shows the process that will be followed to deliver the permanent schools.
