Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project is underway to deliver a new public preschool, primary school and high school for Box Hill. These schools will be delivered as a priority, in addition to new primary schools for Gables and Tallawong, a new high school for Schofields/Tallawong, and upgrades to Rouse Hill High School and Schofields Public School.

To ensure that local families can send their children to a local primary school sooner, Box Hill Public School opened Day 1 Term 1 2025 in purpose-built temporary facilities on George Street, Box Hill.

Box Hill Public School temporary facilities

School operations have begun at the temporary facilities for Kindergarten to Year 2 students. This term, we have worked to maximise shade at the school by:

- installing shade cover along all walkways, which will continue throughout the second stage of the project
- installing 6 picnic tables with shade cover, and
- procurement of a new shade sail structure to cover the remainder of the quadrangle adjacent to the existing COLA, ready for Term 2.

Works have also begun to install the remaining temporary buildings to cater for additional year groups. The area for these additional buildings is fenced off and will remain inaccessible to students and staff until all works are completed.

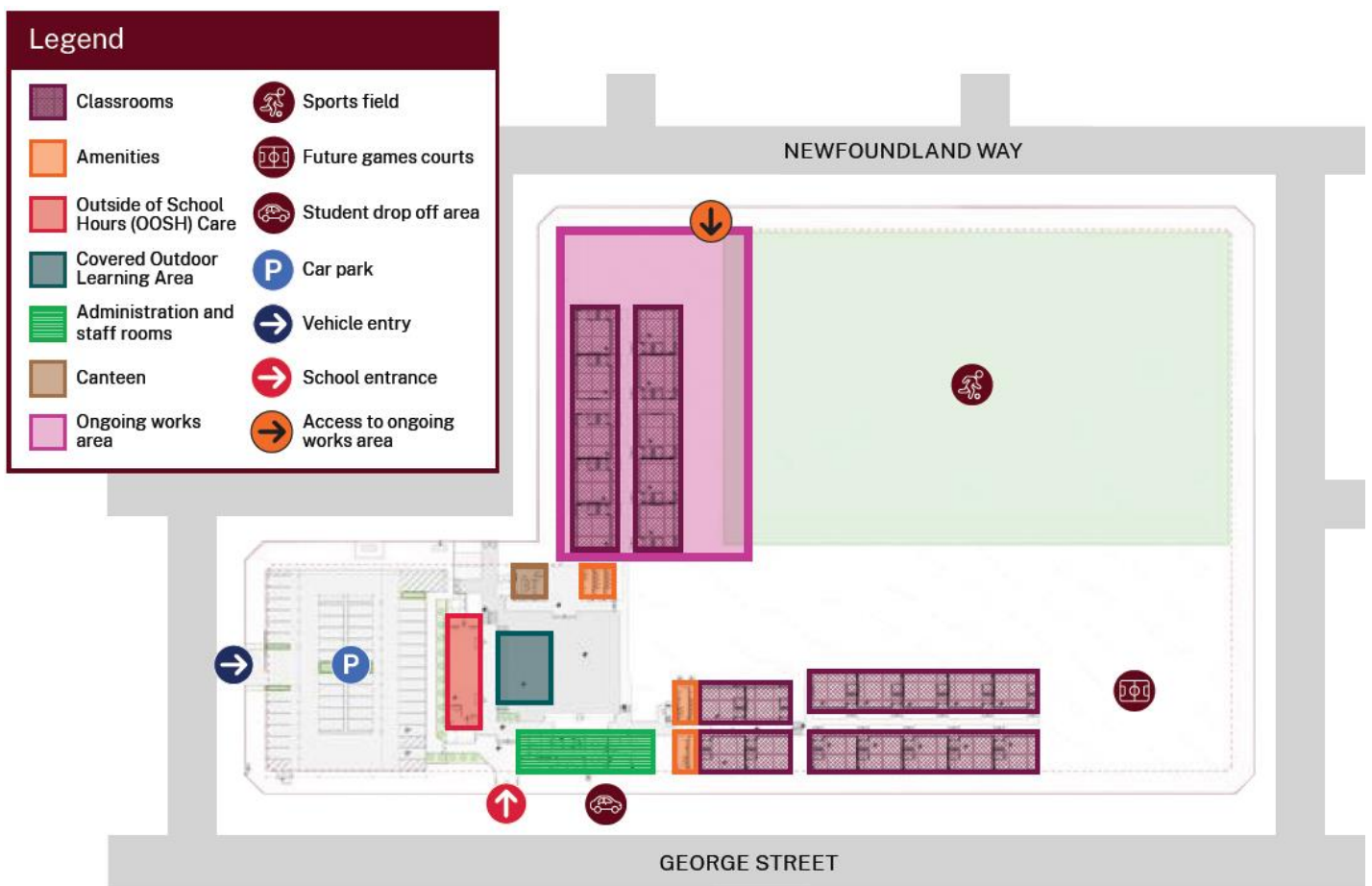
Construction vehicles will access the site via the construction entry on Newfoundland Way and traffic control will be in place as needed.

These works include:

- delivery and installation of 12 new temporary buildings, including a new library building
- pouring concrete pathways
- electrical and plumbing works
- landscaping works around the new buildings.

We are working with Transport for NSW and local Council to identify the transport options for the new school and expect to have more information in the coming months.

Enrolment for Years 3 to 6 is open

Families living in the Box Hill Public School intake area can now submit an online enrolment form for students starting Years 3 to 6 from Day 1 Term 3 2025.

The enrolment page for the school can be accessed by going to the school webpage at boxhill-p.schools.nsw.gov.au or by scanning the QR code.

All applications will be considered in line with the Department of Education's Enrolment Policy which will give preference to families living close to the school and consider families' unique circumstances wherever possible.

The school will be contacting parents and caregivers of all enrolled applicants to provide information about the next steps.

Support will be provided for families electing to transition to Box Hill Public School mid-year to ensure that this change causes minimal impact to student learning.

A team of professional experts, including a project architect are developing the design of the new schools and new public preschool.

We are also preparing the documentation needed for statutory planning approval.

A Project Reference Group (PRG) has been established. The PRG consists of school leadership representatives, a community representative, technical experts and the School Infrastructure project team. The PRG provides advice and feedback throughout the design phases of the project.

A community information session will be held later this year to share the design with the community.

Connecting with Country

For the permanent schools, we have begun the process of Connecting with Country which involves conducting consultation and workshops with local Aboriginal knowledge holders to incorporate feedback and ideas into the school's design.

The process is guided by the principles of the NSW Government's [Connecting with Country Framework](#), and aligned with the departments commitment to delivering our [Reconciliation Action Plan](#).
