Investing in our schools




As part of the NSW Government’s plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Planning is well underway to deliver a new public preschool, primary school and high school for the North Rothbury, Branxton and surrounding communities.

The new primary school will cater for 500 students and will include:

-  27 modern classrooms including facilities for specialist support classes
-  library
-  multipurpose hall and shared canteen
-  outdoor play and sports facilities
-  administration and staff support areas
-  public preschool with capacity for 60 students per day

The new high school will cater for 1000 students and will include:

-  54 modern classrooms including facilities for specialist support classes
-  library
-  multipurpose hall and shared canteen
-  outdoor play and sports facilities
-  administration and staff support areas
-  specialist workshops for VET construction and VET kitchen

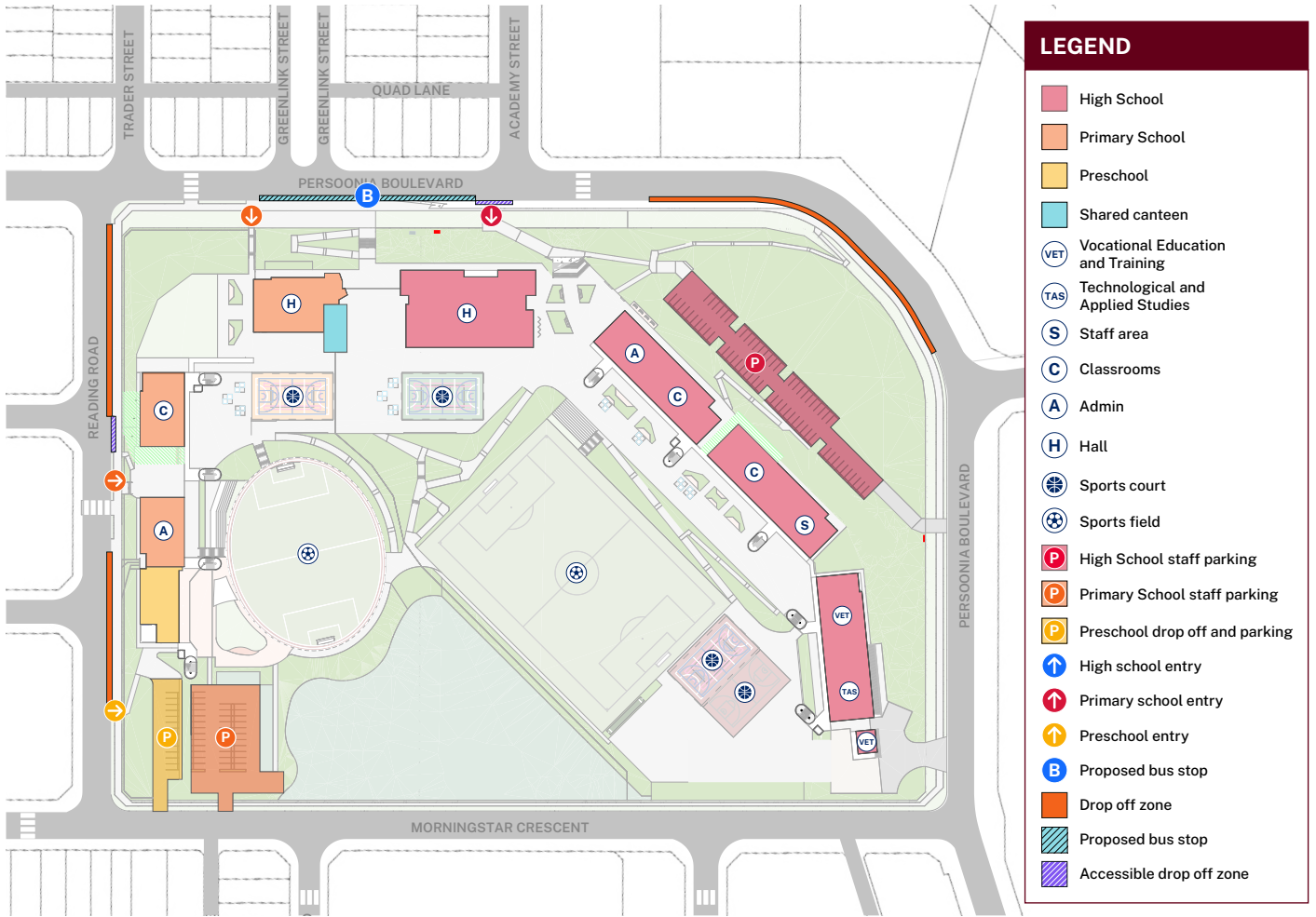
