Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2025-26 Budget is delivering \$2.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in regional NSW. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Planning is underway to deliver a new primary school and public preschool for Calderwood by Day 1 Term 1 2028 to cater for the growing population. The new primary school will include:

- permanent, modern classrooms and open spaces
- core facilities including a new library, hall and covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- administration and staff areas
- support learning classrooms.

Progress summary

Planning is well underway to deliver the new public school and preschool for Calderwood. We have started the statutory planning process and are preparing key documents for the planning application for this project.

Next steps

- Finalise concept designs and ongoing development in consultation with representatives from the Department of Education.
- Finalise and lodge planning pathway documents ahead of the public exhibition.
- Finalise transfer of site to the department.

We are committed to ensuring that the local community are kept informed about the progress of this project. We will be holding a community information session in Term 3 2025. We will provide more information and invitations early next term.
