# Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

The new school will be located on the corner of Crown Street and Hamilton Street in Grantham Farm and will open in early 2028.

# Site plan of our new primary school \*Indicative only, subject to change

To support the growing number of families in the area, the new primary school will initially open for up to 500 students from Kindergarten to Year 6 students, with room to expand in the future.

The proposed masterplan shows where the buildings and key facilities will be located on the new school site.

The school site will include one three-storey building with modern classrooms, support learning spaces, staff facilities and a library. It will also feature a multipurpose hall, a COLA, canteen and outside of school hours care facilities.

The three-storey building has been carefully planned to support learning, cultural connection, and community across the site.

- · Ground Floor support learning classrooms, administration and staff facilities, and modern classrooms
- Level 1-library and modern classrooms
- Level 2-modern classrooms.

The design also includes plenty of outdoor and play space.

The school will be a space for the whole community to enjoy. Facilities like the sports field and hall may be made available for use outside school hours when they are not needed for school purposes.





# Floor plans of the new buildings

# Public preschool

The preschool will feature specially designed rooms, a quality outdoor play area, a dedicated car park, and will accommodate up to 60 children per day.

# **Designing for community and Country**

The landscape strategy for the new school is centred on building strong connections, between people, place, and Country.

The new school design will be guided by the following Connecting with Country themes:

- Together in place: Grounded in community
- · Living with Country: Connecting to non-human kin
- Country as a teacher: Listening and learning from Country.

A key feature of the school is its open outdoor spaces, designed to support play and learning, while celebrating the natural landscape. Existing trees will be retained where possible, and new native plantings will enhance local biodiversity and strengthen the site's connection to surrounding natural elements.

The landscape strategy also incorporates elements of cultural storytelling, including:

- a kangaroo feature within the assembly area
- animal footprints embedded along the main entry path
- a dedicated yarning circle for parents and the community.

These elements support a meaningful connection to Country and foster shared experiences among students, families and visitors.


Note: The building design is still evolving and subject to change.

Drawing inspiration from the Cumberland Plain Woodlands and significant waterways such as Eastern Creek, Catai Creek, and the Hawkesbury River, the design responds to the natural landscape through its material palette, tones, and textures.











# Vineyard Public School

As part of the long-term planning for growth and infrastructure development in the area, Vineyard Public School students and staff will transition to the new school in Grantham Farm once built to mitigate future impacts to its site from the planned Bandon Road upgrade by Transport for NSW. Student learning will continue at the current Vineyard Public School until the new primary school in Grantham Farm is built.

We will work closely with Vineyard Public School and the broader community to support a smooth transition and ensure that Vineyard Public School's legacy and history are reflected in the new school.

Further updates regarding Vineyard Public School will be shared as the project progresses.

### Frequently asked questions

### When will the new school and preschool open?

The new school and preschool will open to students in early 2028. We will keep the community updated as the project progresses.

### When will construction start on the new school and preschool?

A timeline for construction of the new school and preschool will be confirmed once a builder is appointed next year.

### What will the new school be called?

Consultation with the local community will be undertaken to determine a name for the new school.

### What year groups will the primary school open in 2028 and how can I enrol my child?

The new school at Grantham Farm will open for Kindergarten to Year 6 in 2028. Information about how to enrol your child will be available on the department's website when the intake areas have been finalised.

# What will the school intake area be and will students at Vineyard Public School be automatically considered for the new primary school?

The intake area will be confirmed closer to the school opening, typically around 12 months prior. All students at Vineyard Public School will be supported during this transition.

### What will happen to Vineyard Public school's staff?

Permanent staff from Vineyard Public School will retain their positions and will transition to the new primary school in Grantham Farm. Temporary staff will also be supported during the transition process. The new school at Grantham Farm will be staffed in line with the department's recruitment procedures.


