Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

Planning is well underway for a new primary school in Grantham Farm and a new public preschool. This new school will support the growing needs of the Grantham Farm community in the Northwest growth area and allow families to access educational facilities close to home.

As part of the long-term planning for growth and infrastructure development in the area, Vineyard Public School students and staff will transition to the new school in Grantham Farm once built, to mitigate future impacts to its site from the planned <u>Bandon Road upgrade</u> by Transport for NSW.

The future school will be located on the corner of Crown Street and Hamilton Street in Grantham Farm and will open in early 2028.

Progress summary

There has been significant progress on the concept design for the new school, and we look forward to sharing these with the community later this year. The design is being developed in consultation with key technical stakeholders and the Project Reference Group (PRG) which includes school leadership representatives from Vineyard Public School.

Due diligence activities such as flood studies and geotechnical investigations are currently underway on site. These studies will help inform both the design and support the preparation of the Review of Environmental Factors (REF), which is progressing ahead of its upcoming public exhibition in early 2026.

The REF is part of the planning process and includes detailed plans for the proposed construction activities. The community will have an opportunity to view and provide feedback on these plans during the exhibition period.

Next steps

• Continue developing the concept design, complete due diligence studies and prepare key documents to support the REF planning process for the project.


