

New primary school and co-located public early learning for Menangle Park

Planning update | June 2026

Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$4.1 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

We are pleased to announce a project to build a new primary school and co-located public early learning service in Menangle Park, located centrally in the precinct, near the future proposed Menangle Park town centre and future housing.

The new school will have capacity for 500 students and has been master planned for future expansion, providing essential education infrastructure to support population growth in the Menangle Park precinct.

The new school will open to students for Day 1 Term 1 2029.

The project includes:



24 classrooms with shared common areas and multipurpose spaces



3 support learning classrooms



co-located public early learning



multipurpose school hall and covered outdoor learning area (COLA)



full sized playing field, multipurpose sports court and landscaping



kiss and drop spaces and bicycle racks

Progress summary

An initial master plan, which is a basic layout of the proposed site, has been completed. The master plan determines the best use of space on the site, including building placement, landscaping and outdoor areas. It also considers local demographics, educational requirements of the school, future population growth and changes in student enrolment trends.

A Project Reference Group (PRG) has been established as an advisory group, involving local educational experts, architects, planners and design professionals to ensure designs are fit for purpose.



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Location of the new primary school and co-located public early learning



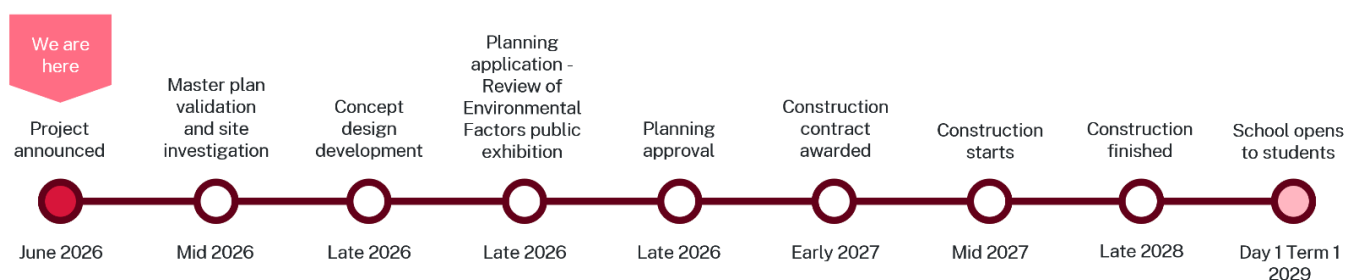
Next steps

We will start site due diligence assessments and investigations later in 2026.

The project's appointed architect is completing work to validate the project's master plan before starting the next stage of design, called concept design. The concept design explores the master plan in more detail, looking at detailed building, room and space layouts and high-level building services like power supply, water supply and drainage.

A community information session will be held later this year to share the plans with the community prior to seeking planning approval.
